Testimonies confirm that
what you're saying is true.

Testimonies can cause people to be
interested in hearing the gospel.

Testimonies can be an
excellent way to start sharing.

If you forget me, you've lost nothing.
If you forget Jesus, you've lost everything!

Two short testimonies every believer has:

“I know I am going to heaven.”

“I have peace.”

Sharing with truth and love:

Be flexible!

Don't emphasize **love**
at the expense of **truth**.

Don't emphasize **truth**
at the expense of **love**.

Paul said:

“...but, **speaking the truth in love...**”

Sharing Illustrations:

Drop of Poison

(Sin is compared to a drop of poison)

“...for **all** have sinned and fall short
of the glory of God,...”

Romans 3:23

Sharing Illustrations:

Medicine Bottle

(Receiving Christ is compared to taking medicine)

“But as many as **receive Him**,
to them He gave the right
to become children of God,...”

John 1:12

Sharing Illustrations:

Road

(Repent is compared to making a U-turn)

“...**Repent**, and believe in the gospel.”

Mark 1:15b

Sharing Illustrations:

Ice Cream

(Comparing the goodness of God to ice cream)

“Oh, **taste** and see that the LORD is good;
Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!”

Psalm 34:8

Sharing Illustrations:

Paycheck

(Comparing when to receive Christ to cashing a check)

“...Behold, **now** is the accepted time;
behold, **now** is the day of salvation.”

2 Corinthians 6:2b

One-Liners:

You can't know the **peace** of God
until you know the **grace** of God. Romans 5:1

You can't know the grace of God
until you **know** you're a sinner.

You can't make disciples
until you make **converts**.

One-Liners:

Share the gospel with **confidence**
because you know it is **true**.

Share the gospel with **boldness**
because you know it is **important**.

Share the gospel with **assurance**
because you know **God** is doing the work.

Isaiah 55:11

One-Liners:

Sharing the gospel is not about ability---
it's about **availability**.

The **importance** of sharing outweighs
the fear of sharing.

The **blessing** of sharing outweighs
the fear of sharing.

One-Liners:

Be "all things to all men",
but **don't compromise**.

Asking for a **commitment** is the
final destination when sharing the gospel.

We can **only imagine** the significance
of leading a person to Christ.

One-Liners:

God uses **committed** Christians.

Satan uses **uncommitted** Christians.

Nothing is worse than
a **bad** example and a **loud** witness.

One-Liners:

Don't assume
those who **attend** church are saved.

Don't assume
unbelievers are not **listening and watching**.

Man's laws **do not** overrule
God's command to share the gospel.

Acts 4:19-20, 5:29

One-Liners:

Don't expect to be loved by the world
for sharing the gospel. 1 John 3:13

It's usually more difficult
to share where sin **abounds**.

God often reveals our weaknesses **before** He
gives His power, boldness and strength.

One-Liners:

Most believers are apprehensive before they
share **and joyful afterwards**. Luke 10:17

Share with the **sensitivity** of a dove
and the **toughness** of a rhino.

Don't worry about results.
That's God's business.

One-Liners:

God gives us relationships with unbelievers
so we can share the gospel.

When you cannot relate to unbelievers,
you can still proclaim the truth.

God uses imperfect Christians,
but not unwilling ones.
